

## RAINE STUDY - CODING GUIDE FOR CARDIOVASCULAR QUESTIONNAIRE (yr 8)

### All Questions

For all questions, except where indicated, code responses as indicated on the questionnaire form.

eg. Q8 N = No Y = Yes  
Q13 1 = Parenting payment 2 = Newstart allowance 3 = Disability support pension  
4 = Workers compensation etc

Where the respondent has been asked to write a number, write that number in the box or boxes provided (one digit to each box). nb. It may be necessary to convert the number from years to months, or weeks to months as appropriate. **nb. 8 and 9 are reserved numbers - only to be used as follows:**

For all questions, 9 (or 99, 999, etc.....) indicates no response, don't know, or an inappropriate response. Where it is important to distinguish between don't know and no response, then a separate code for don't know will be listed.

When a question or questions are not applicable and no response has been made (eg. following a 'No' response with a 'Go to Q' option), 8 ( or 88, 888, etc.....) indicates not applicable.
